Post Op





Yakhoub, the 13 y.o. Muslim boy from Chad, didn't just get his hair cut this week! He had his mitral valve replaced. He is up and walking, but he has some fluid collecting in his abdomen and has little appetite. They are trying to find food that is familiar and comforting to him. We prayed for him in the name of Jesus as the team does each day, hoping he and his father will come to know Who healed him! All of the translation for him and his dad has been done either from a man from a local mosque, through Google translate, or by phone with a resident at another mission hospital who speaks Arabic.

Margaret, 69, has had a rough week! She came in with a longstanding, conained ruptured aneurysm, and seemd stable, but in pain. On Monday morning, though, she took Yakhoub's place in surgery, as she developed severe pain. Russ operated and found a fresh, contained leak of the aneurysm that was about to rupture. Her aorta was severely diseased, presenting a major challenge to repair. After several days of recovery, she suddenly developed severe abdominal pain and right leg pain, and they had to take her back to perform a bypass from her left femoral artery to the right femoral artery. This was a huge undertaking for an elderly, critically ill patient. Thankfully, her kidneys and liver survived all of this trauma without any signs of failure.





We really thank God for her current recovery. This could very easily have led to multi-system organ failure and death. We were pleased to see her today sitting up in bed with stable vital signs today. Please pray for her body and spirit as she continues her slow recovery.



Russ is happy that her foot is warm, a sign that her bypass is healthy!

Mary, 45 y.o. mom of three kids, just had minimally invasive mitral valve replacement. I didn't even know that was a thing! Minimally invasive means that they didn't have to open her entire sternum, but rather made a small incision and inserted a telescope with which they could do the work. She still feels like she's had major surgery for sure, but doesn't have such a big wound to heal from.

Blacksen is a 12 y.o. orphan boy who has had increasing fainting episodes because he has severe Atrial Insufficiency due to RHD. His heart is really struggling to keep his body going. He and his grandmother joined gratefully in as we prayed together for his surgery this week.



Michael is here to have a right lung lobectomy for lung cancer. He had colon cancer nine years ago, but this does not appear to be related. He is a construction worker who fell off a roof several years ago and has been too weak and in too much pain to be able to work. We pray that his lung will heal well and that he will be well enough to get help for his back from one of our neurosurgeons!
