**Amen** --Amina-- had surgery on Monday and made it through, but her little body did not recover, and she died on Wednesday. We are so sad for her mother and family, who had such hope, and for the team who worked so hard to keep her alive. Her mom stayed at and was ministered to by the caring staff at **Mustard Seed House**. I was glad to be able to share the many photos I'd taken of her with her mom before she left.

## **Pre-Ops**

Russ saw patients without me and gave me a brief description of each.



**Lena**, 19 mos., is from the local town of Bomet and has a VSD (Ventricular Septal Defect), which is a hole between the lower chambers of her heart.



**Brittney,** 13 mos., has a large VSD and a small PDA (Patent Ductis Arteriosis), which is persistent fetal circulation that never closed on its own and needs to be surgically closed.



**William,** 5 yrs, is from Migori, towards Lake Victoria. He has a severely stenosed outflow of the left ventricle that goes out to the aorta and thus the entire body. He also has a small ASV.



There will be several more patients this week, but these were the ones already here when Russ rounded.
